QUALIFICATIC	to the CAC. One member shall represent agriculture or other industry and one

REQUIREMENTS:	TS: A City Selection Committee in each County of the Valley shall each appoint one member to represent cities of that County.
	Each appointing body shall appoint an alternate member for each primary member appointed.
	CAC members and alternates must be bona-fide residents of their County.
TERM:	Initial term of members appointed by the City Selection Committee is one year. Initial term of

- Environmental members is two years; Initial term of Industry/Agricultural members is three years. All subsequent appointments shall be for terms of three years. CAC members may be re-appointed to successive terms by their respective appointing bodies.
- DUTIES: Primary responsibility of the CAC: "The Advisory Committee shall meet no less than semi-annually for the purpose of receiving public comments relating to the actions and decisions of the District and to assist the District in effectuating its purposes"

MEETINGS: <u>**Citizens Advisory Committee Meetings**</u> are held via video teleconference (VTC) on the first Tuesday of each month, usually at 10:00 a.m., except July and November, at the Central Region Office (Fresno), Governing Board Room, 1990 E. Gettysburg Avenue, with the Northern Region Office (Modesto), 4800 Enterprise Way, VTC Room, and the Southern Region Office (Bakersfield), 2700 M Street, Suite # 275, VTC Room, participating via VTC.
