NAME: **TUOLUMNE RIVER REGIONAL PARK

ESTABLISHED: June 27, 1989

CONFLICT OF INTEREST: Not required

LEGAL AUTHORITY: Board of Supervisors Resolution #89-877

MEMBERSHIP: The Committee consists of ten (10) members, 5 of whom are appointed by Board of Supervisors:

**QUALIFICATION:
AND RESIDENCY
REQUIREMENTS:** One Representative from each Supervisorial District.
Each must be a registered voter and not a paid City or County employee.
The City of Modesto appoints three (3) members.
The City of Ceres appoints two (2) members.

TERM: 4-Year Term with no term limitation

DUTIES: The Committee is a support group of interested individuals appointed from both the County and the cities represented by the Park Board of Directors to research and develop ideas for providing a flow of income to the park through the following means: a) seeking government support, grants and/or fees; b) developing ideas for completing the park general plan through joint ventures with private entrepreneurs or concessionaires; and c) promoting the park to various local corporations or clubs by encouraging them to participate in the actual development of the remaining portions of the park's master plan.
