The CEO reported that County staff is working diligently to prepare the 2008/09 Mid-Year Budget Report, and that he has implemented some budget saving processes including a soft hiring freeze and a limit on travel for the balance of the fiscal year. He noted that he will discuss the issue of Department

Heads and Assistant Department Heads taking time off at the same time at the next Department Head meeting, and that this issue will be brought to the Board in the future for consideration.
