Supervisor Chiesa spoke regarding the recent CSAC Board of Directors meeting regarding the possibility of the State borrowing Proposition 1A funds. There was discussion regarding returning VLF fees to previous levels if Prop 1A funds are borrowed. The State's fiscal issues will not be improving soon. The Chairman agreed and noted that the State cannot balance their budget by taking local government's funds.

Chairman DeMartini and Supervisor Monteith attended the new airport hangers' ground-breaking ceremony at the Modesto Airport. The project was built using funds from the Stanislaus County share of property tax on aircraft and was completed on time and under budget. This will be a revenue-generating project for the Modesto Airport and the County.

The Assistant Executive Officer noted that the Proposed Budget hearing will be 06/09/2009 at 9:00 a.m. and is on the County's website. She noted that County staff met with our Legislation delegation in Sacramento to provide them with budget information and to keep them updated. She thanked Supervisor O'Brien for his suggestion to provide our legislatures with a list of under-funded and unfunded mandated County programs that are not reimbursed by the State. The Governor is making a budget speech to the State Legislature today. The cash situation in the State is of grave concern if there is not a budget deal reached by 07/01/09, there is estimated to be a \$24 billion shortfall. This will impact the State and Federal programs that the County is mandated to provide. Though the BOS will receive the Proposed Budget next Tuesday, additional budget work will continue over the summer months. SB684 by Senator Cogdill, will freeze the Negative Bailout, which impacts Stanislaus County, and would start in FY 2011-12. The bill has passed the Senate and is going to the Assembly. She invited everyone to the Grand Opening for the Regional Water Safety Training Center in Empire will be on Friday, 06/12/09 at 6:00 p.m. at the Empire Park.
