- *B2 Approved the Mental Health Cooperative agreement with the State Department of Rehabilitation for FYs 2011-2012, 2012-2013 and 2013-2014 for the provision of vocational rehabilitation services for persons with severe and persistent mental disabilities; authorized the BHRS Director, or her designee, to sign Agreement Number 28295 with the State Department of Rehabilitation for FYs 2011-2012, 2012-2013 and 2013-2014, including Form DR 325; and, adopted a resolution to enter into the Mental Health Cooperative Agreement with the State Department of Rehabilitation to provide vocational rehabilitation services to persons with severe and persistent mental disabilities BHRS 2011-436

- *C1 Approved summarily vacating the well easement on Jessup Avenue located west of the town of Keyes; pursuant to Street and Highway Code 8335(a), finds that the well easement depicted on the map (Exhibit B) around a well parcel, as part of the Conditions of Approval of the Parcel Map recorded in Book 42 of Parcel Maps at Page 86, is no longer needed; finds that the recording of the Grant Deed recorded as Document # 94-0067670-00, in which the Keyes Community Services District relinquishes Parcel 1 as shown on said Parcel Map, has eliminated the need for the Well Easement; and, adopted the attached resolution vacating the well easement located on Jessup Avenue west of the town of Keyes and described herein as Exhibits "A" and "B" PW
- *C2 Awarded a contract for all-inclusive engineering and project delivery services to NorthStar Engineering Group, Inc., not to exceed \$277,739.70, for the Crows Landing Road at West Main Street Intersection Upgrade Project; and, authorized the Director of Public Works to execute a contract with NorthStar Engineering Group, Inc., \$277,739.70, and to sign necessary documents, including any amendments to the Agreement, not to exceed 10% PW
