The CEO gave a legislative update and noted that there is a deadline this week to move bills forward at the State Level. She reported that the Oversight Board for the Successor Agency for the Stanislaus Redevelopment Agency approved the reorganized obligation payment schedule (ROPS). This schedule includes projects in Salida, Keyes, Bret Harte and others. The Oversight Board also approved \$32 million to assist Public Works in developing the infrastructure projects including those in the Park Lawn area. The ROPS is subject to approval by the State and the State officials have yet to take action on this. Last week the Governor stated that the State Budget deficit could be \$1 billion more than the \$9.2 billion previously estimated. He will be releasing his mid-budget revision in May. The Munger Tax Initiative appears to have enough signatures to qualify for the ballot. She noted that the Facebook IPO is supposed to happen in May, which could result in another \$2.5 billion in State revenues. On the federal side, last Wednesday, the House approved HR 4348 (Surface Transportation Extension Act of 2012, Part II). This is essentially a \$109 billion two-year surface transportation and reauthorization bill.
