CEO Risen spoke regarding Correspondence No. 2 on today's agenda, and noted that the Board of Supervisors has previously taken action regarding this issue. Staff will prepare a letter for the Chairman to send to the Agricultural Advisory Board letting them know what action the Board has taken.

Supervisor Chiesa reported that yesterday he sat on a panel at USC Price School of Public Policy, co-hosted by the USC Schwarzenegger Institute for State and Public Policy, regarding California's water challenges. He noted that it was a great dialogue with students dealing with public policy, and that he along with other panel members were able to communicate how agriculture is an important part of California's economy.
