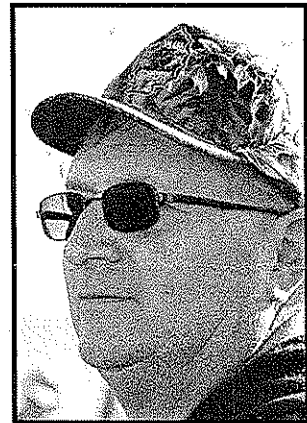

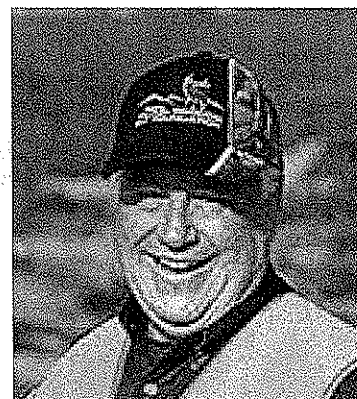
The more you use the cards the more money is generated for the club.

Bowhunter Contest Rules

1. The game specie program has been in effect as of December 1, 1972. For individual hunter competition, the program will have TWO (2) classes;
1. Big Game and 2. Small Game
2. The game specie program shall be as follows;

No member may enter more than one (1) legal bird, mammal, fish or amphibian of any specie in any YAH! bowhunter contest, either for individual or club competition.
3. An individual First Place award may be given for the greatest number of game species taken in a contest by an individual hunter in both the big and the small game classes in the following divisions, Men's (18 years and over), Women's (18 years and over), Junior Men's and Women's (13 through 17 years), Cubs boys and girls (12 years and under).

There will be two divisions in the Large Game category:

1. Out of State Big Game
2. California Native Big Game

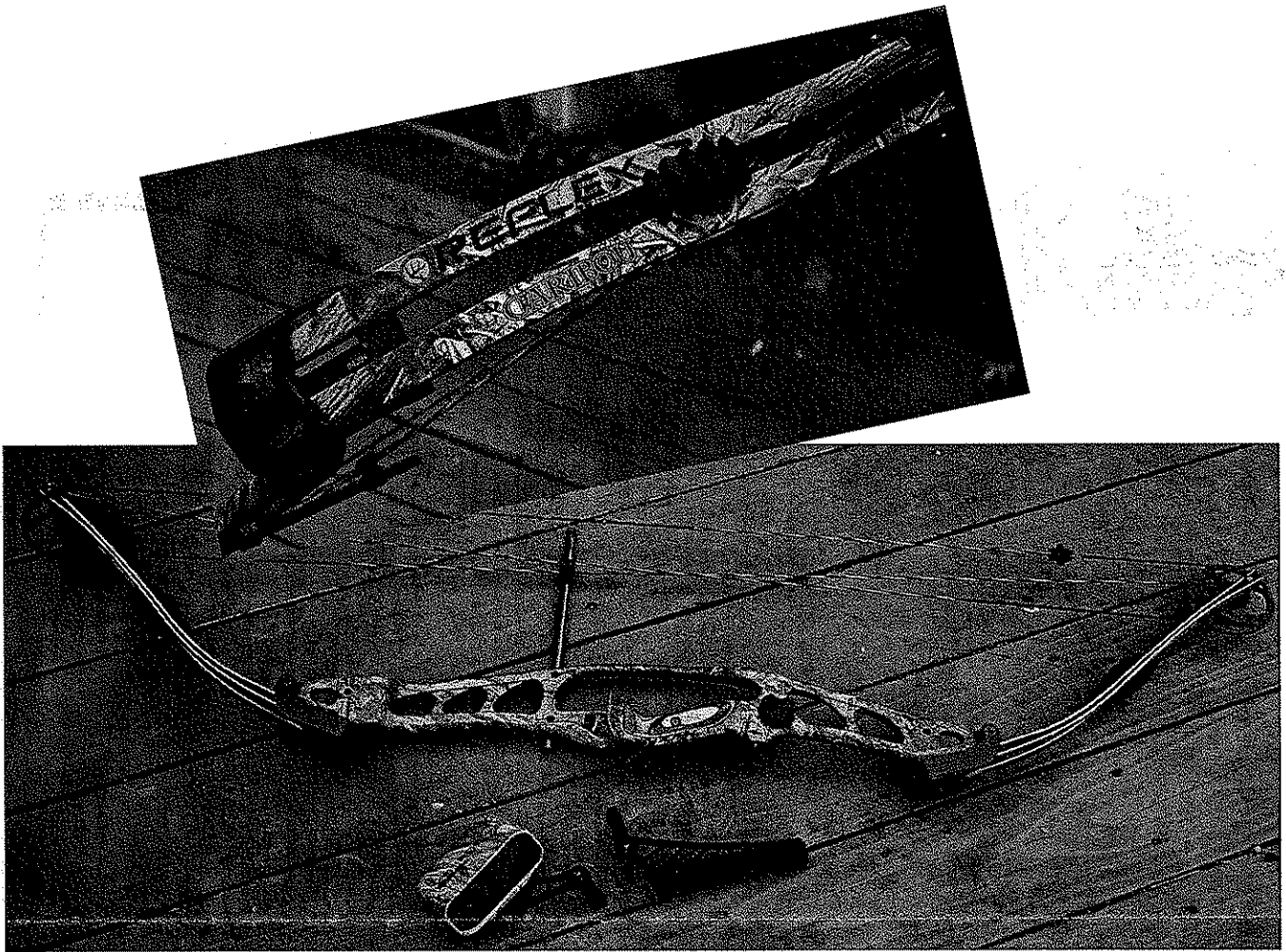
In case of a tie in any of the above divisions, duplicate awards will be given.

4. Participation shall be limited to members of the club who have maintained membership in good standing with the "Yahi Bowmen of Modesto".
5. All game species forwarded to the Yahi game recorder to be entered into the records for the Yahi Bow hunter Contest must have the bowhunters contest report form in by November 17, 2010. That is the date of the next Yahi Club meeting.

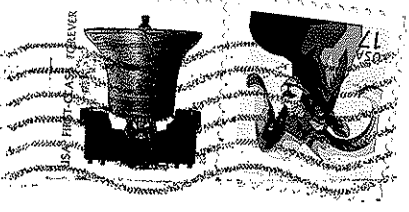
