Stanislaus County Probation Department

The Stanislaus County Probation Department is comprised primarily of three major divisions: Administration, Institutions, and Field Services. Administration, Juvenile Hall and Juvenile Field Services are located at 2215 Blue Gum Avenue, Modesto, CA 95358. Adult Field Services is located at 801 – 11th Street, Suite B100, Modesto, CA 95354.

The department employs 255 people, of which 202 are sworn staff. The base budget for the current fiscal year is \$27,272,245.

The Probation Department is both a law enforcement and corrections agency which has numerous legally mandated responsibilities codified in state law. The principal client of the Probation Department is the court; however, there are numerous other "customers" such as the probationers and detainees under our care, custody and control, law enforcement, victims, at-risk youth and families, the community at large, and our partners in the schools, public/private service providers, other county departments, the State Department of Juvenile Justice, and the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation.
