Find out what's new at the Stanislaus County Library during National Library Week

April 15-21 is National Library Week, a time to celebrate and recognize the value of libraries in Stanislaus County. What better time to visit the library and find out what's new?

Whether you're planning a trip to Europe, learning to cook a new recipe or planning a home improvement project, now you can download a video from the library at <u>www.stanislauslibrary.org</u>. Just go to "Find/Renew Materials," then "My Library DV," enter your library card number and follow the instructions to download videos. My Library DV works like a regular checkout – when you download a video, it stays on your computer for seven days, and then disappears automatically when the week-long checkout is over. Up to 10 video titles can be checked out at one time on each library card. And because the checkout ends automatically, there are never any overdue fines for these items.

The Stanislaus County Library is one of about 30 libraries nationwide to offer this new service, with programs like *Rick Steves' Europe*, *Globe Trekker*, *America's Test Kitchen*, *Michael Chiarello's* Napa, Julia and Jacques Cooking at Home, Antiques Roadshow, and Today's Homeowner.
