Stanislaus County Health Services Agency Conducts Annual Senior Flu-Vaccination Clinics - 20 more clinics to be held during the next several weeks

STANISLAUS COUNTY – The Stanislaus County Health Services Agency has begun conducting senior flu vaccinations clinics, and will conduct 20 more clinics throughout Stanislaus County during the next several weeks (see attached schedule). The clinics will offer flu vaccinations to people at least 60-years-old and other people with chronic medical conditions, for a low cost of \$20 per person. This administration fee may be paid with cash or check, and can be covered by Medicare (Part B with no HMO only). Those with HMO health plans, such as Secure Horizons, Senior Advantage, or Seniority Plus should receive vaccinations from their health care provider.

This season's flu shot will offer protection against A/ Solomon Islands/3/2006 (H1N1)-like virus and A/Wisconsin/67/2005 (H3N2)-like virus, and B/Malaysia/2506/2004-like antigens.
