Detectives Investigate a Shooting that Left Two People in Critical Condition

MODESTO, CA- Sheriff's Detectives are investigating a shooting that left two people in critical condition early Sunday afternoon. The shooting occurred inside a home in the 1100 block of Avalon Ave. A roommate that returned home shortly after 2:00 PM found the two victims inside. The roommate immediately called 911 and EMS personnel and deputies responded. The two victims were transported to two different hospitals in the Modesto area and both are listed in critical condition.

Detectives believe that both male victims were in the home sleeping when unknown suspect(s) entered and shot the victims multiple times. Several witness have come forward and are being interviewed by detectives, but no suspects have been identified at this time.
