Volunteer Income Tax Assistance at local libraries

Free income tax assistance is available at libraries in Oakdale, Riverbank and Waterford this year, thanks to the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program sponsored by the Internal Revenue Service. Volunteers are trained and certified by the IRS. This free service is available to anyone, but priority will be given to low income residents and senior citizens.

Volunteers will provide assistance Feb. 1 through April 14:

- Tuesdays and Thursdays, 5 to 7:30 p.m. at the Oakdale Library, 151 South First Ave.
- Wednesdays, 5 to 7:30 p.m. at the Riverbank Library, 3442 Santa Fe
- Thursdays, Feb. 1, March 1 and March 24, 3 to 5 p.m., at the Waterford Library, 324 E St.

Volunteers expect to assist low-income residents and senior citizens on fixed incomes, to ensure they receive earned income credit and 2007 economic stimulus. VITA volunteers will prepare Forms 1040 EZ, 1040A, 2441, 8863, and 8812. They do not prepare Schedules C, D, E and certain other forms. In addition, they will e-file tax returns for those they assist.
