RESTRAINING ORDER VIOLATOR SENT BACK TO JAIL

Modesto, CA – Stanislaus County Sheriff's Department patrol deputies again arrested 33-year-old Modesto resident Jonathan Brady on Wednesday evening for violating the conditions of his probation, violating a court order and for trespassing.

Deputies were initially dispatched to the Frito Lay distributorship located at 600 Garner Road at approximately 6:52 p.m. to reports of a restraining order violation. A security guard called to report that he could see Brady on surveillance cameras in violation of a known restraining order.

Deputies arrived within a matter of minutes, and they came into contact with Brady, whom had already been arrested three times in the previous week for violating the same order. Brady could not provide any legal or legitimate reason for returning to the business; therefore, he was arrested without further incident. Conditions of the court order clearly indicated he was not to be anywhere near the business or one of its employees. The protected person's identity will not be released for any media relation's purposes.

Brady is being held at the Stanislaus County Men's Jail in lieu of \$5,000 bail. Brady's most recent booking photograph has been provided for the reader's convenience.
