Grand opening of new Family Justice Center and Domestic Violence Conference

WHEN: Friday, October 22, 2010

WHAT: Two major events in regard to domestic violence in Stanislaus County.

1) Grand Opening of the new Family Justice Center. This 9300 square foot facility will be a one-stop location for victims of violence, sexual assault, child and elder abuse. The FJC is a public-private partnership modeled after centers in Tacoma, Washington and New Orleans, Louisiana. More than a dozen partner agencies are taking part in this extremely unique project that has been more than four (4) years in the planning process. Participants and services include District attorney, law enforcement, counseling services, Haven Women's Center, social services and many more. The only Family Justice Center in the north valley.
