SHERIFF'S DETECTIVES INVESTIGATING HOMICIDE

Modesto, CA – Stanislaus County Sheriff's Department investigators are conducting a homicide investigation after finding a 44-year-old Modesto man dead in a trailer park on Thursday evening.

Deputies and emergency medical technicians responded to the Driftwood trailer park located in the 600 block of River Road in Modesto at approximately 6:07 p.m., as callers reported that a person was down and was possibly dead. First responders confirmed the man was no longer alive, and detectives within the Robbery and Homicide Unit of the Sheriff's Department responded in order to further the investigation.

The victim was identified as Modesto and Ceres-area transient, Roy Michael McLain, Jr. Authorities have been able to determine McLain's cause of death; however, the case is still open and details specific to his injuries will not be released at this time. Detectives continue to actively follow leads and are identifying and interviewing all possible witnesses.
