- Introduction of meeting attendees
- Ed Burroughs, Deputy County Counsel and Departmental Equal Rights Officer presented an update on Prop 209. He provided the history and overview of the proposition.
  Specifically, Mr. Burroughs had been asked to provide information on bilingual

recruitments. Prop 209 allows for bilingual recruitments to be conducted, the recruitment is targeting a specific skill (the language) not an ethnic group. Any individual who can speak the language fluently is eligible for the job regardless of ethnic background and/or affiliation.

### EEO TRAINING

**Bridging Diversity** – Last class was January 10, 2008 - 24 attended. Next scheduled training is June 5, 2008.

**Disabilities Awareness** – Last class was February 13, 2008 - 24 attended. Next scheduled training is May 14, 2008.
