BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' ACTIONS OF JUNE 22, 2004

- A. The Board accepted the 2003 Stanislaus County Agricultural Crop Report from the Ag Commissioner and the Farm Gate value of income in Stanislaus County was 1.45 billion dollars for 2003.
