\*A. PARCEL MAP APPLICATION NO. 2004-26 - DIABLO GRANDE - Request to divide a 157.69 acre property to create four parcels of 31.10, 30.79, 86.08, and 9.72 acres zoned Specific Plan (SP) #1 located at Diablo Grande, west of Interstate 5, approximately 10 miles southwest of Patterson. The map is for the purpose of allowing the processing of four subsequent tentative subdivision maps to develop subject property consistent with SP #1. The project is part of an approved Specific Plan and therefore exempt from CEQA.

PARCEL MAP APPLICATION NO. 2004-28, USE PERMIT APPLICATION NO. 2004-17 - OLD GERMAN BAPTIST BRETHREN CHURCH - Request to construct a 15,171 square foot church building on a 3.9 acre portion of a 18.65 acre parcel in an A-2-40 (General Agriculture) zoning district.
