\*A. <u>USE PERMIT APPLICATION NO. 2005-25 - PETROGULF CORPORATION - VANDA PROSPECT</u> - This is a request to drill a natural gas well on a small portion of a 171 acre parcel located in the A-2-40 (General Agriculture) zoning district. The property is located at 1530 Oaklea Road, west of River Road in the Vernalis / Westley / Grayson area. This project is exempt from CEQA.

The property is located at the southeast end of Burkhard Road, west of River Road, east of Highway 33 in the Westley / Grayson area. This project is exempt from CEQA.

\*E. <u>USE PERMIT APPLICATION NO. 2005-01 - RIVER HAVEN NURSERY - Request</u> to establish a wholesale nursery on a 9.09 acre parcel in the A-2-10 (General Agriculture) zoning district. The property is located on the south side of Yosemite Avenue, just east of Skyline Blvd, in the Waterford area. The nursery will include a dry storage/office building, shade structure, cold-frame greenhouse, and shop building. The Planning Commission will consider adopting a Mitigated Negative Declaration.
