Prior to actual Planning Commission consideration, the Chairman will open the public hearing and ask if anyone present wishes to discuss any of the items. If you want a particular agenda item removed from "Consent", <u>please speak up and advise the Chairman</u>. That item will then be withdrawn from "Consent" and reviewed in detail as scheduled. The remaining "Consent" items for which there are no voice objections will be handled by a single action of the Commission.

NON-CONSENT CALENDAR: These items will be individually discussed and reviewed in detail.

ANY MEMBER OF THE AUDIENCE DESIRING TO ADDRESS THE PLANNING COMMISSION REGARDING A MATTER ON THE AGENDA: While the Planning Commission welcomes and encourages participation in the Commission meetings, it would be appreciated if comments are limited to five minutes so that everyone may be heard.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIODS: Matters under the jurisdiction of the Commission, and not on the posted agenda, may be addressed by the general public at the beginning of the regular agenda and any off-agenda matters before the Planning Commission for consideration. - *A. <u>VESTING TENTATIVE PARCEL MAP APPLICATION NO. 2007-15 BOBBY</u> <u>SINGH</u> - This is a request to create two parcels of 9,509± and 9,430± square feet from a 25,000± square foot parcel in the R-A (Rural Residential) zoning district. These parcels will be served by water and sewer from the City of Ceres. The property is located at the northeast corner of E. Service and Collins Roads, in the Ceres area. This project is exempt from CEQA. APN: 053-37-033 [View Item]
- *B. TIME EXTENSION FOR PARCEL MAP APPLICATION NO. 2005-05 MARK KEATON - This is a request for a three-year time extension to October 6, 2010, to record the map for Parcel Map Application No. 2005-05. The project was approved to create two parcels of 4.0 and 4.9 acres in the M (Industrial) zoning district. The project is located on the east side of Beard Road, between El Roya Avenue and Yosemite Boulevard in the Modesto area. This project is exempt from CEQA. APN: 036-008-001 [View Item]
- *C. PARCEL MAP APPLICATION NO. 2007-02- DAVID & LAURA SIMONS This is a request to create a .51 acre parcel and a 1.11 acre remainder parcel from a 1.62 acre parcel in a H-S (Historical Site District) zoning district. Public water will be provided by the Knights Ferry Community Services District. The project is located at 17467 Cemetery Road, on the north side of Cemetery Road, between Sonora and Frymire Roads, in the Knights Ferry area. The Planning Commission will consider a Negative Declaration on this project. APN: 002-036-004 [View Item]

D. VARIANCE APPLICATION NO. 2007-02, LOT LINE ADJUSTMENT APPLICATION NO. 2007-03 AND WILLIAMSON ACT CANCELLATION APPLICATION NO. 2007-01 - FRIENDS OF THE TUOLUMNE - This is a request to adjust lot lines from approximately 40.36, 68.74 and 115.2 acres to approximately 8.76, 71.96, and 144.7 acres in the A-2-40 (General Agriculture) zoning district. application is necessary to allow creation of an 8.76 acre parcel by lot line adjustment, which is less than the 40-acre minimum requirement. If the proposed lot line adjustment is approved, it will be necessary to process a Williamson Act Cancellation for the 8.76 acre parcel, which is a portion of Williamson Act Contract No. 2002-4481. The property is located at 23792 and 23806 Yosemite Boulevard, north of the Tuolumne River and south of Rushing Road, in the Waterford area. The Planning Commission will consider a Mitigated Negative Declaration on this project.

E. <u>GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT APPLICATION NO. 2006-07, REZONE</u> <u>APPLICATION NO. 2006-11 - BELASKI REPAIR SHOP</u> - This is a request to amend the General Plan and to rezone the subject property from A-2-40 (General Agriculture) zoning district to P-D (Planned Development), to authorize and legalize an existing, non-permitted vehicle repair shop. The request involves approval of the conversion of an existing 2,400 square feet agricultural shop/building for the purposes of conducting full-service vehicle repair. The project is located at 2306 Gondring Road, east of Central Avenue, in the Ceres area. The Planning Commission will consider a Negative Declaration with this project. APN: 041-014-028 [View Item]
