Prior to actual Planning Commission consideration, the Chairman will open the public hearing and ask if anyone present wishes to discuss any of the items. If you want a particular agenda item removed from "Consent", <u>please speak up and advise the Chairman</u>. That item will then be withdrawn from "Consent" and reviewed in detail as scheduled. The remaining "Consent" items for which there are no voice objections will be handled by a single action of the Commission.

NON-CONSENT CALENDAR: These items will be individually discussed and reviewed in detail.

ANY MEMBER OF THE AUDIENCE DESIRING TO ADDRESS THE PLANNING COMMISSION REGARDING A MATTER ON THE AGENDA: While the Planning Commission welcomes and encourages participation in the Commission meetings, it would be appreciated if comments are limited to five minutes so that everyone may be heard.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIODS: Matters under the jurisdiction of the Commission, and not on the posted agenda, may be addressed by the general public at the beginning of the regular agenda and any off-agenda matters before the Planning Commission for consideration. However, California law prohibits the Commission from taking any action on any matter which is not on the posted agenda unless it is determined to be an emergency by the Board of Supervisors. Any member of the public wishing to address the Commission during the "Citizen's Forum" period will be limited to a maximum of 5 minutes.

New agenda items will not be heard after 11:00 p.m. If agenda item is not fully discussed by 12:30 a.m., it will be continued at the discretion of the Chairman.

A. <u>USE PERMIT APPLICATION NO. 2006-38 - ALP CUSTOM SPREADING, INC - Continued from December 20, 2007.</u> Request to allow a manure spreading business to operate on three (3) acres of a forty (40) acre property, located in the A-2-40 (General Agriculture) zoning district. The proposed project is for the parking and maintenance of vehicles associated with the spreading operation. The project is located at 2324 Villa Manucha Road between Villa Manucha Road and Azevedo Road, north of Newman. The Planning Commission will consider a CEQA Negative Declaration on this project.

REZONE APPLICATION NO. 2007-07 WILLIAM ROSSI Request to rezone nine acres from A-2-10 (General Agriculture) to Planned Development, to establish an appropriate commercial use for the site, which includes an existing agricultural equipment sales business and will add a manufactured home sales business, a business/sales office, employee and customer parking, walkways, and model homes for customer viewing. The project site is located at 4831 Esmar Road, at the southern terminus of Esmar Road and Rohde Road, in the Ceres area. - C. VARIANCE APPLICATION NO. 2007-02, LOT LINE ADJUSTMENT APPLICATION NO. 2007-03 AND WILLIAMSON ACT CANCELLATION APPLICATION NO. 2007-01 FRIENDS OF THE TUOLUMNE Request to adjust lot lines from approximately 40.36, 68.74 and 115.2 acres to approximately 3.95, 71.96, and 148.39 acres in the A-2-40 (General Agriculture) zoning district. A variance application is required that if the lot line adjustment is approved, one of the parcels will be reduced from 40.36 acres to 3.95 acres, which is less than the 40-acre minimum requirement. If the proposed lot line adjustment is approved, there is a

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proposed Williamson Act Cancellation for the 3.95 acre parcel, which is a portion of Williamson Act Contract No. 2002-4481. The property is located at 23792 and 23806 Yosemite Boulevard, north of the Tuolumne River and south of Rushing Road, in the Waterford area. The Planning Commission will consider a CEQA Mitigated Negative Declaration on this project.
