If necessary, adequate drainage easements shall also be included on the recorded map or recorded rights. An informal note referencing these rights shall be added to the recorded version of the map.
- 3. The location Existence of the Tidewater Associated Oil Company System and the Old Valley Pipeline shall be shown noted on a separate information sheet to be recorded with the final version of the map to be recorded.
- 25. **Prior to building permit issuance,** the project shall comply with fire apparatus access standards. Two ingress/egress accesses shall be provided.
