> of sand and gravel on 92 acres of two (2) separate properties with a combined acreage of 852± acres in the A-2-40 (General Agriculture) zoning district. The project sites are located south of Yosemite Boulevard (Highway 132) and the Tuolumne River, and east and west of Roberts Ferry Road, in the Waterford area. This project is exempt from CEQA.
