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\*B. USE PERMIT APPLICATION NO. 2007-10 – FOSTER FARMS DAIRY NO. 4

EXPANSION – Continued from April 18, 2013. Requesting continuance to June 6, 2013. Request to expand an existing dairy by adding three (3) free stall barns and a special needs barn. The modified dairy would house 2,400 animals (an increase of 1,680 cows from existing numbers). The proposed expansion is on a 38 acre portion of two (2) parcels totaling 610± acres in the A-2-40 (General Agriculture) zoning district. The remainder of the two (2) parcels will still be used to apply manure process water & grow forage crops. The property is located on the northeast corner of the Hickman Road and E. Keyes Road intersection, south of Hickman, northeast of Denair. The Planning Commission will consider Certification of a Final EIR.
