\*A. <u>VESTING TENTATIVE PARCEL MAP APPLICATION NO. PLN2014-0026 – ARG INVESTMENTS</u> - Request to subdivide a 3.93± acre parcel into six parcels ranging in size from 20,087 to 36,877 square feet in the M (Industrial) zoning

district. The site currently contains six buildings ranging in size from 4,875 to 12,000 square feet and consists of mostly warehousing. All of the proposed parcels will have access to Lone Palm Avenue by way of a 30 foot private road easement. The property is located at 1121 Lone Palm Avenue, on the west side of Lone Palm Avenue, southwest of N. Emerald Avenue, north of Doker Drive, and east of Reno Avenue, in the Modesto area. The project is exempt per section 15061(b)(3) of the California Environmental Quality Act.

22. Carver Road is classified as a 60-foot Local Road. The required ½ width is 30-feet west of the roadway centerline of Carver Road along the frontage of Parcel 1 of the tentative **parcel** map. If 30-feet of road right-of-way west of the roadway centerline does not exist, the remainder of the 30-feet not previously dedicated shall be dedicated with an Irrevocable Offer of Dedication with the recording of the final map. This offer will only be accepted if the County has a fully funded roadway project in the area of the Irrevocable Offer of Dedication.
