PLN2015-0034 – WESTSIDE HULLING ASSOCIATION</u> - Request to expand an almond and walnut hulling operation by adding a 6,000 sq. ft. shop and four 10,000 sq. ft. agriculture storage buildings on a 20± acre parcel in the A-2-40 (General Agriculture) zoning district. The property is located at 206 Frank Cox Road, at the intersection of Frank Cox and Highway 33, in the Patterson area.
