PLN2018-0090 — HONCHARIW – FRYMIRE ROAD - Request to subdivide two parcels, totaling 32.2 acres, into three 5-acre parcels and a 17.2± acre designated remainder. Proposed parcels 1, 2, and 3 are located within the A-2-5 (General Agriculture) zoning district. The designated remainder is proposed to be split zoned with 4.26± acres zoned A-2-5 and the remaining 12.94± zoned as HS (Historical Site District). The project site is located at 17442 Cemetery Road, on the southern corner of Cemetery and Frymire Roads, abutting the Stanislaus River, in the Community of Knights Ferry.
