Request to amend Chapter 6.85 Hemp Cultivation and Chapter 21.20 - General Agriculture District (A-2), of the Stanislaus County Code. The amendment will adopt a permanent ordinance for the cultivation of hemp in the A-2 (Gen Ag) zoning district of the unincorporated areas of Stanislaus County. The permanent ordinance will set standards for hemp cultivation, registration, nuisance, revocation, and payment of fees. Chapter 21.20 is proposed to be amended to include the hemp cultivation regulations by reference. This project is considered Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. APN: County-wide.

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Approved the Planning Commission's Recommendation of Approval for Rezone Application No. PLN2020-0073 – Elum, Inc. - a request to rezone 5.7 acre parcel from Planned Development (P-D) (300) to a new Planned Development to allow for the operation of a labeling machine assembly and repair business in two phases. The project site is located at 4918 Taylor Court, between E. Keyes and Taylor Roads, west of State Route 99, in the Keyes/Turlock area.
