- June 8, 2021: Set a public hearing on June 29, 2021, at the 9:00 a.m. meeting, to consider the Planning Commission's recommendation of approval for Use Permit and Development Agreement application No. PLN2020-0023 Vulture Farms. This project is located at 4612 Glass Court, between Glass Lane and Galaxy Way, South of Kiernan Ave, in the Modesto Area. However, the Applicant has withdrawn the Application, the item will not be heard by the Board of Supervisors on June 29, 2021, as previously scheduled.
