## I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 11:45 a.m. by Chief Probation Officer Jill Silva. Members of the group introduced themselves. Chief Silva thanked Sheriff Christianson for hosting the meeting because JJCC members were invited to tour the Day Reporting Center scheduled to be dedicated on August 13<sup>th</sup>.

## III. APPROVE APRIL 2015 MEETING MINUTES: JJCC

Chief Silva invited Council members to attend the Day Reporting Center dedication on August 13<sup>th</sup>. Also, the Probation Department will hold their 15<sup>th</sup> Annual Open House on Saturday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Tours of the Juvenile Commitment Facility will be available at this time.

Sheriff Christianson noted that the new Coroner's facility will be dedicated on August 6<sup>th</sup>.

#### VI. SUGGESTIONS FOR NEXT MEETING'S AGENDA

Chief Silva reported that the Probation Department will be working with the NCCD, Impact Justice and Probation Departments in the Central region to measure the LGBT youth that are coming into the juvenile facilities. She noted that a one-day snapshot in the State showed that 20% of the population in juvenile facilities is LGBT youth and 30% of these youth are females. Chief Silva also noted that a report will be received from the Burns Institute on the racial and ethnic disparities (R.E.D.) grant project.

Chief Silva reported that she is on a State legislative committee established to improve data reporting on juveniles for JJCPA and JABG. Therefore, the annual report given in October regarding the JJCPA and JABG programs might be postponed.
