

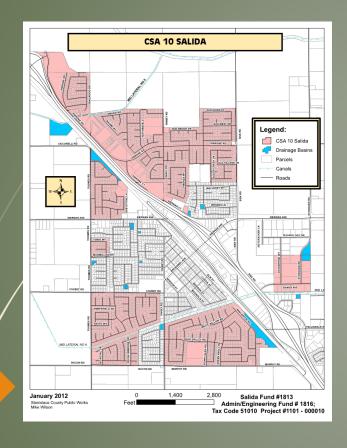

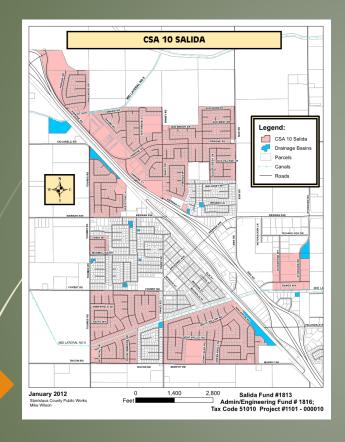
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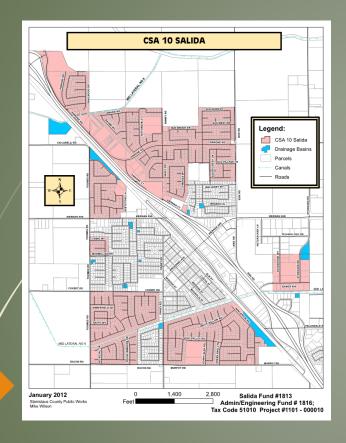
# CSA 10 Background

- CSA 10 is a special district that is funded by property owners and pays for special services
- Special services include:
  - Maintenance for your storm drain system and additional street sweepings (2x per month)
  - Maintenance for your parks, play equipment, streetscapes, graffiti abatement



### **Recap from November**

- Current revenue being collected is insufficient to pay for the expenses to provide those special benefit services
- County staff proposed a \$78/yr rate increase
- Over 75 people attended
  - 20 left comment cards
    - 10 were in favor of rate increase
    - 9 were against rate increase
      - 5 wanted all of Salida to pay fair share for storm drain



# **Alternative Option**

 Staff listened and explored an alternative solution

 All Salida residents receive a benefit from the storm drainage system – an expanded CSA to include CSA 4 and the old Salida portions is the most equitable for all.

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# CSA 4 "Bristol Glen"

- CSA 4 is a special district that is funded by property owners and pays for special services
- Special services include:
  - Maintenance for your storm drain system and additional street sweepings (2x per month)
- Current rate is \$31.38/yr per parcel



## Proposed CSA 4 Annex

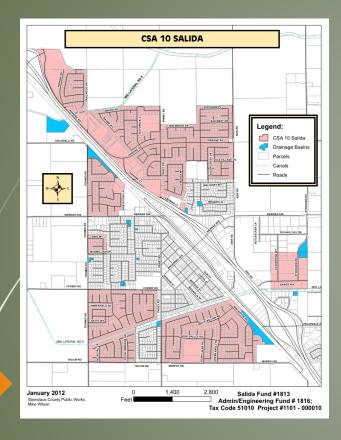
- CSA 4 137 parcels
- CSA 10 2,874 parcels
- Remainder of Salida 1,388 parcels
- New CSA 4 Boundary will incorporate all 4,399 parcels
  - LAFCO Process
    - Rate remains same during annexation



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## **Benefits of Annexation**

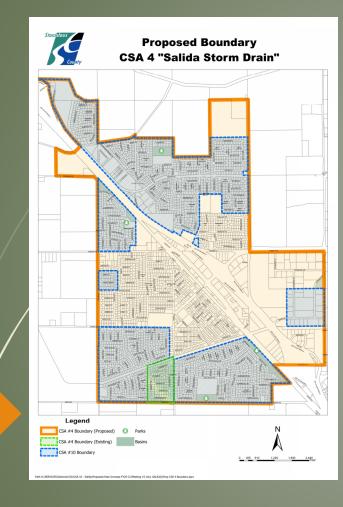
- Everyone will be paying a fair share for storm drain maintenance
- The CSA 10 fee earmarked for storm drain and street sweeping (\$52 of the \$139.32) will be reallocated by the Board of Supervisors to fund the deficit for Parks' services WITHOUT a rate increase



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### CSA 10 Benefits for Parks

- Park Services (Total 4 Parks, 21.87 Acres)
  - Mowing, Edging, Blowing
  - Irrigation systems and Backflow testing
  - Play equipment
  - Restrooms
  - Vandalism repairs
  - Rodent abatement
- Streetscape Services (Total 5.4 miles)
  - Mowing, Edging, Blowing
  - Low Tree Trimming
  - Hedge Trimming
  - Weed abatement
  - Graffiti abatement
  - Irrigation systems and Backflow testing



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## **LAFCO Process**

- BOS authorizes County staff to submit an application to LAFCO
  - 3 month review process
- LAFCO Commission Review Hearing
  - (if approved, 30-day reconsideration period)
- LAFCO Protest Hearing
  - (minimum of 21 days after 30-day period)
- Certificate of Completion
  - (if upheld, 3 days after protest hearing)



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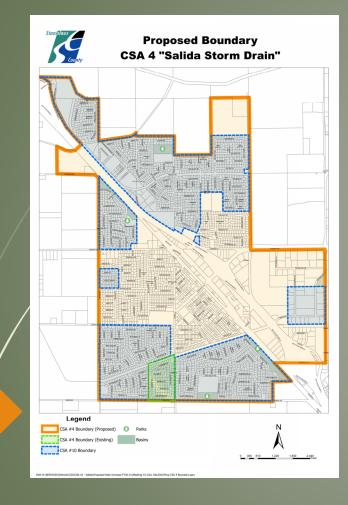
### Assessment w/Annexation

Initially after annexation, everyone will be paying a fee for storm drain maintenance services

	Current	Increase	Total
CSA 10	\$139.32	\$31.38	\$170.70
CSA 4	\$31.38	\$0	\$31.38
Remainder of Salida	\$0	\$31.38	\$31.38

 If approved, first assessment is due Fall 2020

 $2004 \rightarrow \$139.32$  inflation  $2019 \rightarrow \$189$ 



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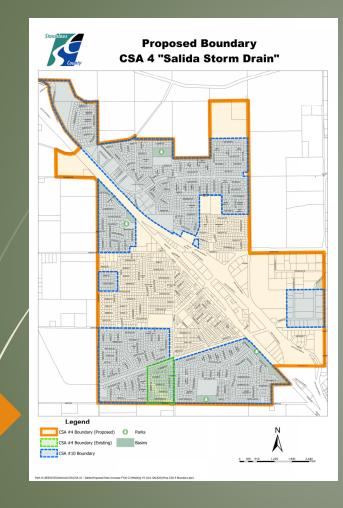
## **New Assessment**

- While everyone in the new CSA 4 is paying for storm, it will not generate enough revenue to pay for all maintenance costs.
- After annexation is complete, a rate increase from \$31.38 to approximately \$64/year will be proposed to pay for normal storm drain maintenance for the next 5 years.

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## Prop 218 vote

- To approve: no response required
- To disapprove: 50% +1 of owners need to mail a protest ballot (minimum of ~2,200)
- If approved, first assessment is due Fall 2021
- If increase fails, then
  - Street sweepings reduced, then pumps after that

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## Salida Area Public Facility Fees Agency – Mello Roos

- Mello-Roos is a tax that pays back the initial construction costs of the community common infrastructure. This is a 30-year bond and does not pay maintenance costs. This is \$812.86 / lot. Salida Area Public Facilities Finance Agency (SAPFFA) the Mello-Roos bond is due to be paid off on September 1, 2030.
- The bond financed: Dena Boer School, Sisk E.S., Salida Middle School, Salida Sanitary Sewer District plant expansion, Segesta Park, Murphy Park, Wincanton Park, Countrystone Park, buses for Modesto Schools, Ciccarelli Fire Station and the land for Gregori HS.
