


PROJECT OVERVIEW & BACKGROUND



PROJECT LOCATION







CURRENT ROAD & BRIDGE





- Historic bridge constructed in 1925
- Does not meet current Caltrans design standard
- Severe rain causes flooding
- Maintenance not cost effective



PROJECT BACKGROUND



Objective:

Provide long-term, safe access across Dry Creek

Benefits:

- Improve alignment
- Enhance safety
- Raise bridge to minimize flooding







PLAN VIEW

Cross section view of proposed Tim Bell Road Bridge







PROPOSED DESIGN




Box Girder Arch Bridge










ENVIRONMENTAL PROCESS





- Identified project environmental impacts
- Proposed avoidance, minimization and mitigation measures, as appropriate
- California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)
 Lead Agency = Stanislaus County
 Prepared Draft Environmental Impact Report
 (EIR)
- National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA)
 Lead Agency = Caltrans
 Determined project is categorically excluded from NEPA process
